## **Police Accountability Commissioner Questionnaire**

The key role of the Police Accountability Commission (PAC) is to provide community-based accountability via a variety of interactions with members of the public, the Independent Police Auditor, the Davis Police Department, and others. The PAC, along with the Independent Police Auditor, is a critical means to create more accountability and transparency in policing.

All voting members of the Police Accountability Commission, regular and alternate, shall be appointed by the City Council (with the exception of the ASUCD representative). Appointment of commissioners shall reflect a diverse representation of the community and include members of various ethnicities, racial backgrounds, sexual orientations, economic status, etc. A minimum of two members appointed by council shall have demonstrated previous adverse interactions with the Davis Police Department. Additionally, no member will have a law enforcement background.
