Approval of the Nishi housing project increases the need to address the fleeting opportunity to connect the downtown to the UCD campus.

My recent proposal for a shuttle that connects the UCD entry area to the downtown will be effective only if property holders appreciate the potential value of being part of this system.

Critical participants are the Nishi property developers and the Lincoln 40 developers who must allow easements for an electric “people mover” shuttle to convey residents along the south side of the tracks and help to activate the downtown with new people and customers.
