## Approved Consent Calendar items:

- ✓ Design Services for Russell Blvd. Green Street Demonstration Project

## Regular Calendar items:

- Open Space Program Strategic Plan
  - o Action: Approved plan to guide decisions regarding acquisition/management of open space through 2030
- Surveillance Technology Ordinance
  - o Action: Introduced ordinance to govern the acquisition, use, and sharing of data from surveillance technology. Requires new policies, public hearings, and annual reports.
- Downtown Public Restroom Facility Type & Location
  - Action: Approved Portland Loo (or similar) as the facility type and G Street Plaza as the primary and E Street Plaza as the secondary location. Next steps will include planning of overall upgrades to include public art, landscaping and possibly new hardscapes.
- Storage of Personal Goods for Unhoused Individuals
  - o Action: Smaller-scale short-term storage opportunities may be pursued via the faith based community. Homeless Outreach Coordinator tasked with outreach to better understand the need for larger storage accommodations; results will return to Council for discussion of options within the next few months.
- Prohibit Aggressive & Obstructive Conduct & Unattended Personal Property in Public Places
  - o Action: Introduced ordinance to prohibit (1) aggressive conduct not currently prohibited by state law, (2) soliciting within 15 ft. of an ATM (currently 50 ft.), (3) blocking or disrupting traffic including certain activity in median strips, (4) blocking sidewalk or entrance to building; as well as require individuals to leave private property upon request of police or property owner.
