Using the same firm will expedite recruitment process since firm is already familiar with City and its goals and objectives.</li> </ol> </li> <li>Council determined, in light of the upcoming June election, the recruitment process could start as soon as possible, but the final decision to hire a new City Manager would be made after the June election.</li> <li>Council determined its preference is to engage an Interim City Manager who is not a current city employee.</li> <li>Council directed staff to reach out to potential external candidates and to seek input for possible interim candidates from the search firm. The City Council would like to meet candidates in the next few weeks with the goal of having a qualified person on board before Mr. Pinkerton leaves.</li> </ol>
