Public Comments

David Thompson, Twin Pines Cooperative, and Luke Watkins spoke regarding Twin Pines Cooperative Foundation v. Davis Area Cooperative Housing Association and city administration of affordable housing programs. Comments included: request city to not take any action on DACHA until the lawsuit is settled, Council should monitor activities of affordable housing staff, request an independent audit of DACHA Board activities.

Ethan Ireland and Jeanne Johnson, DACHA, stated DACHA is making a good faith effort to reach a settlement and that most residents are not involved whatsoever with allegations specified in the lawsuit.

Pam Nieberg and Eileen Samitz requested Council allow a committee of citizens to write the Argument in Favor of Measure R (renewal of Measure J).

Consideration of Language for Arguments in Favor of City of Davis Measures on the June 8, 2010 Ballot City Attorney Harriet Steiner explained that the Council Subcommittee will draft the ballot language and submit it to the City Manager's Office, where individual Councilmembers may come to sign the document. If individual Councilmembers want to suggest revisions, the city must schedule another open session meeting.

S. Souza stated the Subcommittee intends to finalize the Argument language by March 8 in order for there to be enough time to call a special meeting if needed.
