A. Public Forum on Recent Hate Incidents in the Davis Community

The Human Relations Commission provided an opportunity to discuss and receive public input on recent hate incidents in the Davis community.

- Ongoing situation in Woodland about school board trustee ranting about trans rights
- DPC and library are presenting a three part film and series on gender bias
- State of CA Civil Rights Department has created an online portal and phone number for reporting hate crimes and incidents. Statistics have been released 180 incidents received. No incidents documented in Yolo County at this time.
- In Southern California there were multiple attacks at Pride events, school board meetings, etc.
- Juneteenth related attack in Chicago. Local Juneteenth celebration does organize and prepare for keeping the crowd safe.
