The Commission will consider recommendations to update or modify the City's current leaf blower ordinance (Section 24.02.040(b) of the Davis Municipal Code). A Commission-appointed representative of the Recreation and Parks Commission (RPC) will participate in the discussion, provide feedback as needed, and report back to the RCP.
