- 4. Investigate, review and recommend to the City Council ways to implement the Yolo County Solid Waste Plan and improve city-wide recycling efforts;
- 5. Advise the City Council on issues relating to the preservation of agricultural lands in Yolo County;
- 6. Advise the City Council on ways to promote the use of renewable sources of energy;
- 7. Advise City Council on environmental matters relating to toxic and hazardous substances;
- 8. Report to the City Council, other City commissions and departments recommendations for legislation and other actions that would limit actual or potential threats to the natural resources of the region:
