1. Called to Order:

The meeting was called to order at 7:07 p.m. by Acting Chair Wise.

No one from the public spoke. Acting Chairperson Wise closed the public hearing.

B. Social Services Commission Work Plan.

Staffmember Foster outlined the future meeting items on the work plan, and reminded the Commission that the next meeting would be in two weeks to complete the CDBG and HOME funding recommendations.

Commissioner Toney asked for more information regarding the availability of services for runaway youth in Yolo County, specifically services providing shelter. Staffmember Foster stated she would bring more information to the Commission after staff looked into the question.
