Current Monthly Wastewater Rates

Three Components:

Fixed Charges

(1) Base Charge

Recovers admin and billing costs

(2) Per Unit Charge

- Recovers fixed sewer service costs
- Residential customers only, commercial customers pay higher variable charges

Variable Charges

(3) Volume Rate / Variable Charge

- Recovers demand-related sewer service costs
- Commercial charges based on wastewater flow and strength
- Residential flow estimated with winter water use Dec - March
- Commercial customers pay more

No wastewater rate increases since 2015


