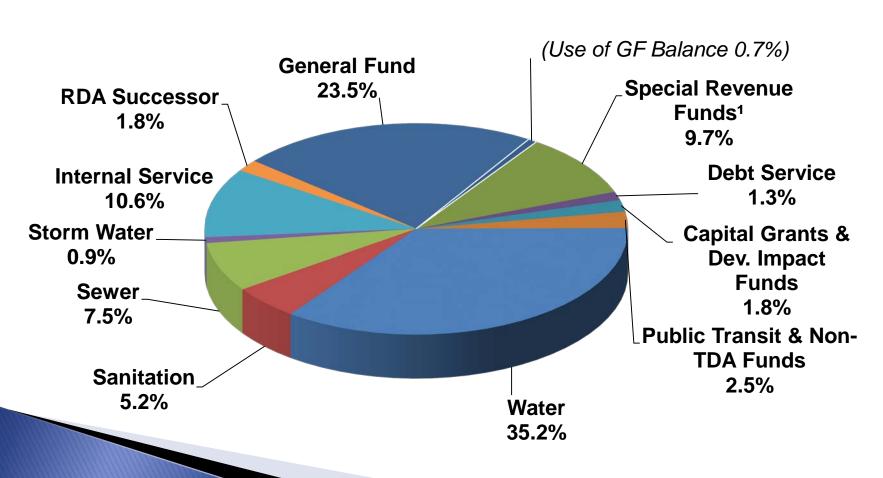

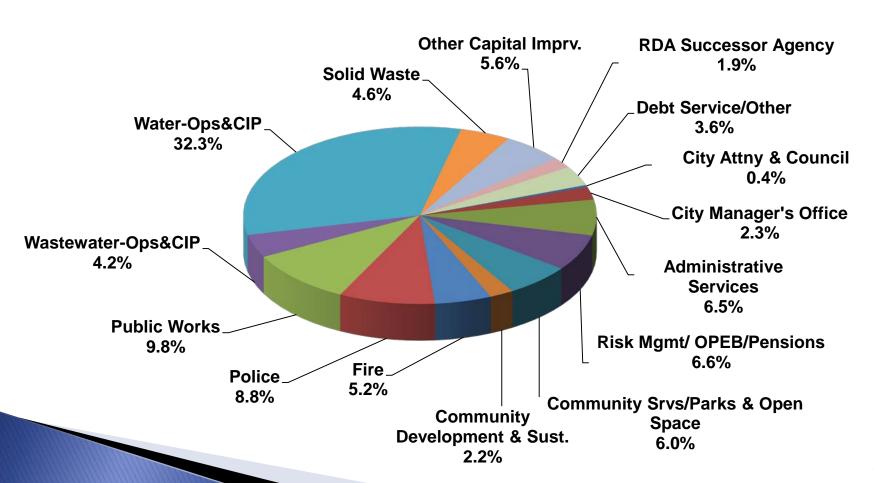
FY 2014/15 Proposed Budget

Expenditures - All Funds \$196,146,382

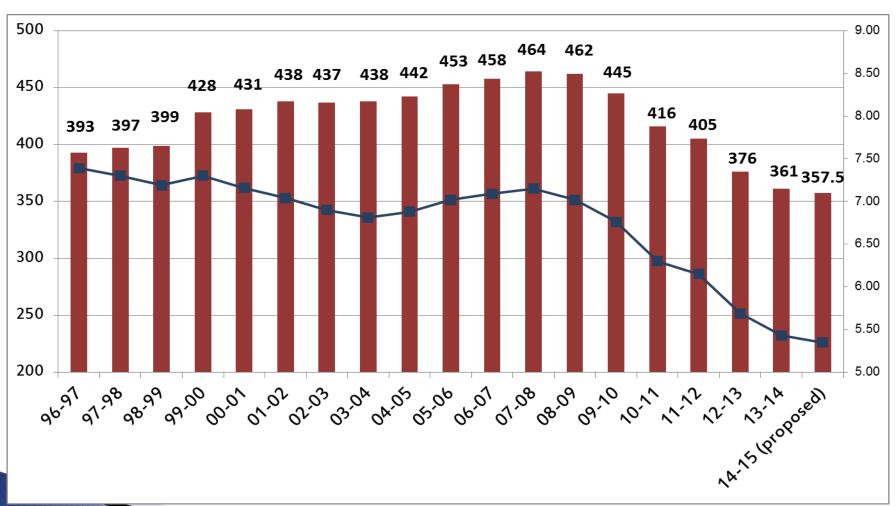




Staffing Trends Permanent Employees (FTE) -Regular Authorized Positions

What's in Proposed Budget?

- ▶ Infrastructure (\$2.5 M in new GF funding, total of \$4.7 M budgeted in FY 14/15).
- Parks Water Conservation (\$500k).
- First year of repayment to Leave Fund and Fleet Replacement (\$415k).
- ▶ \$1.2 Million GF reductions.
- Updated Cost-Allocation Plan.
- **Employee costing** per labor agreements.
 - Second full year of funding for OPEB

Changes from April Budget Presentation to Current Proposed Budget

- Beginning Balance \$160K increase
- Revenue (\$681k)
 - (\$600k) Removal of Public Owned Utility (POU) loan

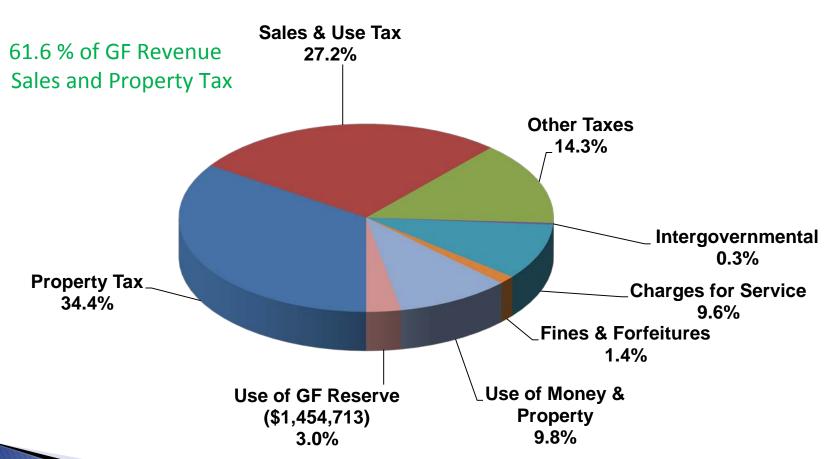

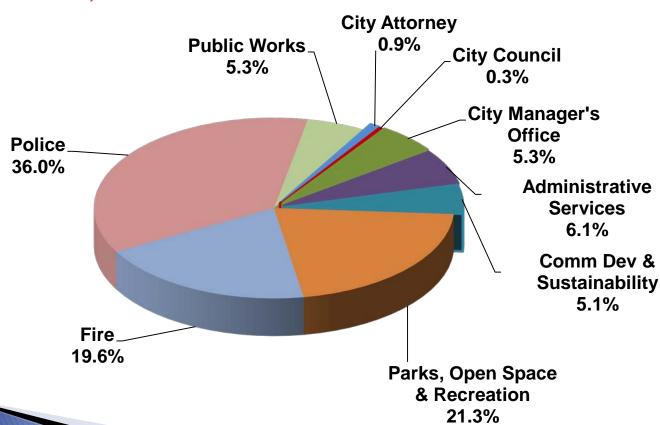
