#### FIREARMS COORDINATOR

## **Duties of Firearms Coordinator**

The firearms coordinator is responsible for: purchasing and inventory of ammunition and firearms, firearms maintenance and repair; firearms instruction and qualification; selection, coordination, training, and supervision of firearms instructors; maintenance of firearms training records; and development of policies and procedures relating to firearms.

The coordinator is appointed by and serves at the pleasure of the Police Chief.

## Minimum Requirements

Police Sergeant with minimum of 2 years experience as firearms instructor.

#### FIREARMS INSTRUCTOR

### **Duties of Firearms Instructor**

A firearms Instructor falls under the supervision of the Firearms Coordinator. Duties include: firearms instruction and qualification; maintenance of firearms training records; and development of policies and procedures relating to firearms.

An instructor serves at the pleasure of the Police Chief.

# <u> Minimum Requirements</u>

Sworn officer who is off probation. Officer is required to attend and pass a P.O.S.T. approved firearms instructor class prior to final appointment. Therefore, candidates may be required to pass the entrance firearms qualification shoot prior to selection. Candidates should have a strong interest in firearms and shooting. Prior teaching or trainer experience is desirable.

# **Application Process**

Upon announcement of a vacancy, qualified officers must submit a letter of interest to Professional Standards, which includes; time in law enforcement, previous specialty assignments, and any special skills possessed which could benefit the team. Applicants who meet the minimum requirements for the position will be invited to participate in an interview panel. The interview panel will then make a recommendation to the Police Chief, or their designee, for appointment.

#### FIREARMS ARMORER

## **Duties of Firearms Armorer**

Duties include: assisting the firearms coordinator with the purchasing and inventory of ammunition and firearms; firearms maintenance and repair; sending firearms to qualified gunsmith; maintaining Armorer's certification for Sig Sauer, Glock, Colt M16, Beretta, and Heckler and Koch; and responsibility for department owned firearms.

An armorer serves at the pleasure of the Police Chief.

# Minimum Requirements

- 1. Current Department Firearms Instructor
- 2. Above average knowledge of firearms types, manufacturers, models, and history.
- 3. Completion of Armorer's certification courses.

## **Application Process**

Upon announcement of a vacancy, qualified officers must submit a letter of interest to Professional Standards, which includes; time in law enforcement, previous specialty assignments, and any special skills possessed which could benefit the team. Applicants

who meet the minimum requirements for the position may be invited to participate in an interview panel. The interview panel, if used, and/or the Firearms Coordinator will then make a recommendation to the Police Chief, or their designee, for appointment.
