Safety Guidelines

A. Application

General safety guidelines apply to all Davis PD sponsored DTAC training. The intent of these guidelines is to promote student and staff safety awareness in areas involving psychomotor skills training and to reduce the potential risk for injuries. Each training presenter and coordinator will be furnished with a copy of these guidelines.

All training instructors and staff will be responsible for adhering to all applicable safety guidelines, policies, and approved course outlines and lesson plans.

B. Safety Guidelines

1. There shall be at least one instructor for each 8 trainees during all DTAC training, excluding lectures.
2. Trainees shall be briefed on hazards to a particular training site.
3. Trainees shall wear clothing that will allow for flexibility of movement. Students wearing glasses shall have shatterproof lenses and eyeglass retainers.
4. Instructional staff shall wear the approved instructor clothing which clearly identifies them as an instructor.
5. Trainees shall be briefed as to expected behavior during training. Horseplay shall not be tolerated.
6. Any trainee who does not follow any safety rule shall be immediately removed from the training site and shall be directed to contact the Professional Standards Lieutenant.
