# HOW TO PERFORM VEHICLE ABATEMENT



## WHAT DOES THE DAVIS MUNICIPAL CODE STATE?

### 22.08.050 Use of streets for storage of vehicle prohibited.

- (a) No person who owns or has possession, custody, or control of any vehicle shall park such vehicle upon any street, alley or city parking lot for more than a consecutive period of one hundred twenty hours without driving such vehicle.
- (b) In the event a vehicle is parked or left standing upon a street, alley or city parking lot in excess of one hundred twenty hours without being driven, any member of the police department authorized by the chief of police may remove such vehicle from the street, alley or city parking lot in the manner and subject to the requirements of the Vehicle Code of the state.
- (c) **Vehicle,** for the purposes of this section, means a device by which any person or property may be propelled, moved or drawn upon a highway, except a device moved exclusively by human power or used exclusively upon stationary rails or tracks.
- (d) **Driving** and **driver**, for the purposes of this section, mean moving a vehicle under its own power. **Driving** and **driver**, for the purposes of this section, do not include pushing a vehicle. (Code 1964 § 4-3.1003; Ord. 357; Ord. 1557



### WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

<u>Step 1</u>: Visit the location or described address to track down the vehicle

Step 2: Clearly identify the reported vehicle by verifying the license plate or pictures and provided description details from the complaint Step 4: Use the chalk to properly mark either one or both of the tires facing away from the curb with a few lines and directional arrows and draw a "U" on the asphalt outlining the tire(s) you have marked

Step 3: Begin filling out Side 2 of the blue vehicle abatement notification trifold. (You may complete Side 1 as well if you were able to successfully enter a license plate number when you created the incident report)

<u>Step 5</u>: Take 3 photographs which should include:

->An image of the rear license plate

->1-2 images of the vehicle (standing a significant distance away) so an assessment of positioning/movement of the vehicle can be determined on the towable date

- B. No person shall abandon a vehicle upon public or private property without the express or implied consent of the owner or person in lawful possession or control of the property.

WARNING – Pushing your vehicle or attempting to rubb away the tire markings, does not comply with the law. The vehicle must be moved under its own power. Failure to do so will result in the towing of your vehicle per 22651(k)CVC, and/or the issuance of a citation for 2253(a-b) CVC,



In the event a vehicle is parked or left standing upon a street, alley or city parking lot in excess of 120 hours, any member of the police department authorized by the Police Chief may remove such vehicle from the street, alley or city parking lot in the manner and subject to the requirements of the Vehicle Code of the State.



## UPDATE THE INCIDENT IN RIMS WHEN YOU RETURN TO THE PD

Step 1: Locate the number on the incident you created

Step 2: Enter it into RIMS by typing "I" into the small box and then the cursor will automatically shift over to the adjacent box so you can then enter the number

# LAST BUT NOT LEAST IMPORTANT, YOU NEED TO PUT TOGETHER THE ABATEMENT PACKET AND MAILER FOR THE REGISTERED OWNER AND FOR OUR AMAZING VIPS!

Bring the middle portion of the blue trifold card up to records once you have filled it out completely so it can be mailed to the registered owner of the vehicle.

A complete packet should include all of the following:

- A printout of the incident with the bottom portion of the blue trifold attached
- 2. A print out of the 10-29 DMV check
- 3. All of the photographs you captured
