\* Designation Level:

“Landmark” means buildings, structures, objects, signs, features, sites, places, areas, cultural landscapes or other improvements of the highest scientific, aesthetic, educational, cultural, archaeological, architectural, or historical value to the citizens of the City of Davis and designated as such by the City Council pursuant to the provisions of Article 40.23 of the city's Municipal Code. A landmark is deemed to be so important to the historical and architectural fabric of the community that its loss would be deemed a major loss to the community. Once designated, Landmarks are included in the Davis Register of Historical Resources. Landmarks were formerly designated as “Outstanding Historical Resources.”

“Merit Resource” means buildings, structures, objects, signs, features, sites, places, areas, cultural landscapes or other improvements with scientific, aesthetic, educational, cultural, archaeological, architectural, or historical value to the citizens of the City of Davis and designated as such by the City Council pursuant to the provisions of Article 40.23. Once designated, Merit Resources are included in the Davis Register. Merit Resources were formerly designated as “Historical Resources.”
