

RESOLUTION NO. 26-059, SERIES 2026

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAVIS REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF YOLO TO CONSOLIDATE A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 2026, WITH THE STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THAT DATE PURSUANT TO SECTION 10403 OF THE ELECTIONS CODE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Davis called a General Municipal Election to be held on November 3, 2026, for the purpose of the election of two (2) Members of the City Council, one in District 1 and one in District 4; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has approved and determined to submit to the voters at the election a question relating to development of the unincorporated land north of the intersection of East Covell Boulevard and Alhambra Drive for the purposes of developing the Willowgrove project; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the General Municipal Election be consolidated with the Statewide General Election to be held on the same date and that within the city the precincts, polling places, vote centers, and election officers of the two elections be the same, and that the Election Department of the County of Yolo canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election and that the election be held in all respects as if there were only one election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Davis does hereby approve as follows:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the requirements of Sections 10002 and 10403 of the California Elections Code, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo is hereby requested to consent and agree to the consolidation of a General Municipal Election with the Statewide General Election on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, for the purpose of the election of two (2) Members of the City Council, one in District 1 and one in 4, and to submit the following question to the voters:

Shall Resolution No. 26-052 be adopted to amend the Davis General Plan to approve a residential development to include parks, trails, open space, and neighborhood retail areas, by changing the land use designations for the Willowgrove property from Agriculture to Urban Agriculture Transition Area, Park/Recreation, Neighborhood Greenbelt, Neighborhood Retail, and Residential Low, Medium, and High Density, and by establishing the Baseline Project Features? SECTION 2. The Yolo County Elections Office is authorized to take all necessary steps to hold a consolidated election and canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election. The election shall be held in all respects as if there were only one election, and only one

form of ballot shall be used. The election will be held and conducted in accordance with the provisions of law regulating the statewide election.

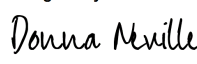
SECTION 3. The Board of Supervisors is requested to issue instructions to the County Election Department to take any and all steps necessary for the holding of the consolidated election.

SECTION 4. The City of Davis shall reimburse the County of Yolo for all costs and expenses incurred by the County in conducting said election upon presentation of a bill to the City.

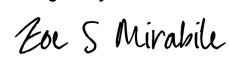
