B. Report of the Martin Luther King Jr. Tribute

The Commission discussed the 2022 virtual Martin Luther King Jr. virtual tribute, what was successful and ways that could be improved for future virtual events.

- Consider hosting event outside in future
- Able to share with online network shared in East Coast
- Consider outdoor in Central Park and hybrid to share online to reach larger audience
- In future post snippet of videos with image of speaker with You Tube link
- · Encourages having subcommittee work on in future years

Public Comment:

Hirsch- Suggest to have merchants opportunity to participate, no publicity in Davis Enterprise despite City press release, ask Enterprise to reflect values of community

Gorman - Remember larger structural issues that MLK was fighting against. Supports hybrid options moving forward.

D. Committee Updates

Committees provided updates as needed

 Asian American & Pacific Islander Outreach (Festejo Hsu, Mvondo, Wong-Chen) – Change name to Anti Hate Committee

The subcommittee provided a presentation on anti-Asian hate crimes and statistics. They encouraged the commission to reflect on what statistic surprised them the most and to think about what the HRC can do to address this happening in our community.

Surprised:

- o Spitting
- Number of young children reporting hate crimes/activities
- Stress on Asian communities and people
- Mental health reporting reminds of us how important mental health resources and access exists
- Helpful to have data around age range of individuals

What can we do as HRC to address community?

- Find out what other communities have done to make marginalized community members feel safer and be safer?
- Outreach with survey to Davis
- o Importance of outreach for all people of all ages and communities
- Safe spaces on k-12 campuses. Learn to understand how to make students feel more safe
- Intergenerational how to build anti hate/pro love community

- Send messages to let people know they are accepted. Could Senior Center outreach assist with this – check in's, ask the question if they feel safe
- o Teach people to be Upstanders.
- Local Voices Project (Mvondo, Varney, Willson)
 The subcommittee provided an update presentation on the curren work of the Local Voices Project
 - o Ready to launch into data collection
 - Shared drafts of outreach flyers, survey and informational materials
 Commissioner Comments:
 - Commissioners appreciate work of LVP
 - o Applauds that it is created in both English and Spanish
 - o For other projects, suggests reaching out for translation
 - Who/How distribution? List has been collected of community based organizations
 - Way to let people know that it is for all interactions and for all people?
 - Reminder that Willson is on Community Advisory Board for Police Department and can bring information forward to them
- · Commission Topic Inventory (Roland) Committee ended
- UC Davis Connection (Allen, Coate, Wong-Chen) –
 Organizing a project coordinating with different campus groups who are involved in social issues to establish rapport, getting information to talk about them having them present to bridge the gap. Talk about issues that students are going through on campus or on City.

Might consider clubs and organizations and collaboration with UC Davis workers and unions. Statewide virtual town hall tomorrow around UC Covid response and long term options – hybrid.

Hirsch – Wishes to have presentations in advance. Wishes comments were not at the end. Prevention is better than treatment. What is source of violence? Media. Talking to Strangers is a wonderful book to read.
