Comments:

- Live streaming in-person performances to You Tube or City Facebook page
- Performance based makes live streaming a bit easier.
- Highlight women and non-men involved in Civil Rights Movement
- Expand beyond Dr. MLK to talk about other contributions.
- Tie into current work that is continuing legacy of MLK.
- Talk about broader movement instead of single figure
- Organized labor, coordinated efforts
- Celebrate and recognize broad range of experiences that Black people have faced in America
- Outreach ideas involving local groups and partnering with groups such at BSU at UCD or high school with compensation.

- Have survey after the event to hear people's feedback. How to distribute?
- Campus celebration of MLK that include cross over of any kind?
 - Explore greater engagement with UCD
- Mental Health, engage with new department
