SUBJECT: Arroyo Park Survey Results and Zipline Update

Recommendations

Receive the Arroyo Park survey results and make recommendations regarding:

1. Recommend one of the following locations of the proposed picnic shelter:
 - A. Outside the aquatics complex; or
 - B. Inside the aquatics complex.
2. Consider options on the Zipline as set forth in this report and provide recommendations on possible next steps.

Fiscal Impact

Funding for the picnic shelter project will come from Proposition 68 Recreational Infrastructure Revenue Enhancement (RIRE), General Fund and Park Impact Fees. Each option for the Arroyo Park Zipline noted below will have a fiscal impact, which will be presented and discussed further in the report. Depending upon recommendations and next steps, potential sources of funding for the project will come from General Fund, Park Impact Fees and/or Community Enhancement Funds acquired from various development projects.

Council Goal(s)

This project is consistent with the following 2019 – 2021 City Council goals:

Goal 4 – Fund, Maintain and Improve the Infrastructure

Goal 5 – Ensure a Safe, Healthy and Equitable Community

Background and Analysis

In February 2019, City staff conducted a survey with residents living within 1000 feet of Arroyo Park about the recent and future amenity improvements made at Arroyo Park. Over 846 postcards with a QR code link were mailed to residents to review and submit back to the City during February 18 to the end of business day March 5. The survey asked about the following topics:

1. Use of the outdoor exercise equipment and frequency
2. Use of the tot (small) and primary (large) equipment and frequency
3. Use of the Zipline and frequency
4. Future use - asking for a ranking and location of a shaded picnic area
5. Asked to identify other amenity ideas that they would like to see

Survey results

The City received 504 responses on Survey Monkey and two handwritten responses (received via email on March 16, 2019) replies back for a 60% response rate. (*attachment 1*).

Question 1/2 – Outdoor Exercise equipment:

397 or 79.56% stated that they or a member of the household use the outdoor fitness equipment

254 or 65.13% use the equipment at least 1-3 times per month

Question 3/4 – Small play area

337 or 67.94% stated that they or a member of the household use the tot area

200 or 55.71% use the equipment at least 1-3 times per month

Question 5 – New swing

283 or 57.06% stated that they or a member of the household use the new swing

200 or 55.71% use the equipment at least 1-3 times per month

Question 6/7 – Large play area

426 or 86.59% stated that they or a member of the household use the large area

430 or 52.09% use the equipment at least 1-3 times per month

Question 8 – Whale climbing structure

392 or 84.67% stated that they enjoyed the whale climbing structure

Question 9/10 – Skytrack/Zipline use

439 or 88.51% stated that they or a member of the household use the zipline

214 or 48.97% use the equipment at least 1-3 times per month

Question 11 - Skytrack/Zipline enjoy

454 or 94.39% stated that they or a member of the household enjoy the zipline

Question 12 – Preference of shaded picnic area

294 or 66.67% stated that they preferred the picnic area outside the aquatics complex

165 of 37.08% stated that they preferred the picnic area inside the aquatics complex

Question 13 – Other amenity ideas for the park:

Question 14 – Residence

472 or 97.72% of those responded live in Davis city limits

The overall results suggest that the majority of those surveyed have enjoyed the new amenities and renovations made to Arroyo Park over the last 3 years.

Arroyo Park Picnic Shelter

Based on feedback received, it is recommended that staff work with Stantec, an on-call landscape design firm for the City, to begin conceptual renderings and for staff to conduct community outreach meetings in the near future for a shaded picnic located outside the Arroyo Aquatics Center. Staff would return to the RPC afterwards for review and a recommendation for moving forward.

Zipline

454 responses or 94.39 % of the responses enjoy the Arroyo Park Zipline. There were 215 comments submitted for this question, of this amount there were 197 positive comments, 13 comments raising concerns, and 5 comments of no opinion or were not familiar with this amenity. Of the comments received with concerns about the Zipline, most were centered on the issue of noise generation.

Noise Analysis

In light of some of the noise concerns being raised the City of Davis retained Bollard Acoustical Consultants, Inc. (BAC) to evaluate the noise generated by the Zipline at Arroyo Park and to compare those noise levels against applicable daytime City of Davis noise standards at the nearest residences. The City's daytime standard for maximum noise level is 55 decibels (dBA), which is applicable at the nearest residential property line.

The test was conducted on Monday, July 22, 2019. Measurements were taken at three different locations (*attachment 3, figure 1*). Noise measurements 1 and 2 represent the locations of residences to the immediate south of the Zipline. Measurement 3 was located to the west of the Zipline area. Appendix B shows representative photographs of the Zipline measures program. During the measurement period, the two Zipline tracks were operated in a near continual fashion by persons of varying weights to simulate worst-case conditions.

The results of the study show that noise generated by the Zipline were consistently lower than average noise ranging from 44 to 46 dBA. These noise levels were satisfactorily relative to the City's 55 dBA standard at the nearest residences by a considerable margin (9-11 dB below the standard). The Figure 3 data indicates that the measures maximum noises levels did not exceed 55 dBA at any time during the Zipline noise test, it would not be possible for average levels to exceed the City's 55 dBA daytime level, even with constant usage of both Zipline tracks being used concurrently. The noise ordinance threshold for night lowers to 50dBA. While the Zipline still meets this standard based on the testing performed, it does push very close to the 50DBA limit.

The analysis concludes that noise generated by the Zipline play equipment in Arroyo Park is satisfactorily relative to the City's noise ordinance standards. However, it is important to note that while the equipment meets the technical and legal standards that the City has established, that does not mean that the equipment and its associated noise are not without impacts on a practical basis, particularly to those who reside near the equipment (e.g. it does not mean neighbors are not negatively impacted from a subjective standpoint).

While the vast majority of survey responses were positive towards the Zipline, there were concerns raised that have prompted staff to engage with the Recreation and Parks Commission to discuss ideas and options for consideration. Certainly, the installation of the Zipline was never intended to introduce a nuisance or to disturb nearby neighbors. Outreach that was done in advance of the installation was not as robust as it would be by today's outreach processes since employed by the City. That said, even if additional outreach had been conducted prior to the installation of the Zipline noise concerns may not have necessarily been identified as a possible issue. There are instances, such as may be the case here, where unintended consequences or impacts may not be fully known until after installation and real-world use takes place.

The fact that the vast majority of park users enjoy the Zipline is certainly a testament to the popularity and accessibility of the equipment. In fact, several respondents noted that they travel to Arroyo Park specifically to utilize the Zipline. Staff believes that those who enjoy the Zipline will enjoy it and utilize it irrespective of the precise location of it within Arroyo Park. Therefore, in light of the few, but perhaps acute, concerns that have been raised about the Zipline, staff believes that it is prudent to engage with the Commission to gauge interest in exploring options that can ideally create a "win-win" scenario whereby the Zipline is situated so that it can still be enjoyed by everyone, but provided greater separation from adjacent homes so as to reduce the noise impacts. Options are outlined below. The

Recreation and Parks Commission is asked to discuss these options and provide a recommendation on possible next steps to inform further staff analysis, in no particular order:

1. Keep the Zipline as is, locking up the amenity nightly:

When the amenity was open (prior to COVID), operating hours of the Zipline were 8 am to sunset. This option would require Parks staff to unlock the amenity daily in the morning and for a Part-Time Staff (TPT) to lock up each night. The cost to have a staff person come out each evening to lock up the amenity would be \$15 per hour on a 2-hour minimum call out - \$30 per day/ times 365 days would cost approximately \$10,950 year. Use of volunteers may be an option to utilizing paid staff, but may raise concerns about having 100% reliability and therefore lead to frustrations about it either not being locked and resulting in night time use, or not being unlocked, leading to frustrations about it not being usable during the day. While the process of locking and unlocking reduces the possibility of inappropriate night time use, it may not fully satisfy neighbor concerns and may not be the best long-term use of City staff time and funds.

The Zipline can be re-opened as soon as personnel are available to lock/unlock the amenity and COVID constraints allow.

2. Relocate the Zipline to another location at Arroyo Park:

An alternate location for the Zipline could be identified (closer to the pool complex or other options that staff and the RPC may identify, for example), thereby creating a more centralized place and further separation from nearby homes. While one-time costs would be associated with a re-location, such a move could serve to negate the need for locking and unlocking and the cost associated therewith, and make the feature more visible to a greater number of park users. A very preliminary construction estimate is \$9,900 (includes disassembly, removing old concrete footings, removing concrete around metal posts so as to not damage the integrity of the steel). Cost to re-install at a new location will depend upon the site work that needs to be done in preparing the site for the Zipline (surfacing). If concrete borders, ADA ramp and EWF (engineered wood fiber) are needed.

Community outreach would be conducted for a new location(s) options, staff would develop more detailed cost estimates, and then return to the Commission for review and final recommendation. The Zipline can be re-opened as soon as personnel are available to lock/unlock the amenity and COVID constraints allow.

With re-location of the Zipline, the existing site could be re-purposed for an additional net new park amenity. Possibilities include, but are not limited to: corn hole boards, a bocce court, or additional play equipment, such as climbing structures or swings, obstacle courses (net-style), or free-standing equipment such as a – spin structure or 4 person seesaw, for example.

Given past concerns with this location when it was previously a fire pit area, activities that encourage group gathering may have noise concerns of their own. The City would have the ability to take time necessary to engage with the neighborhood and park users to solicit feedback on a range of ideas and options before reaching a recommendation and returning to the Commission for action. The cost and funding source for the new amenity would be identified after further development, but could include grant funds, park impact fees, or community enhancement funds.



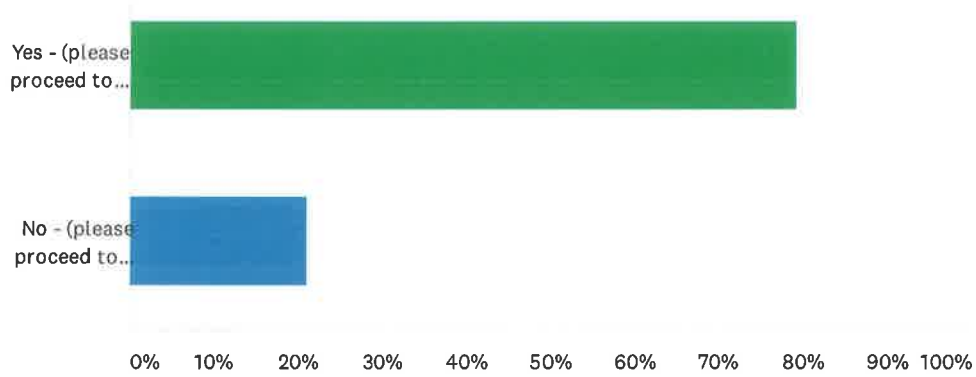

Ultimately, it is staff's intent and desire to create win-win solutions that serve to retain the maximum enjoyment and accessibility of our parks as possible, while maximizing community harmony and not resulting in situations of "winners and losers" if at all possible.

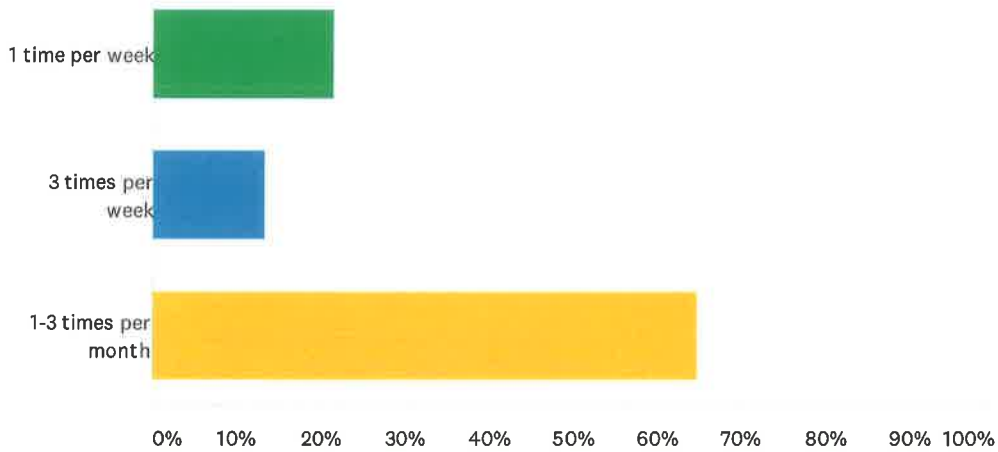

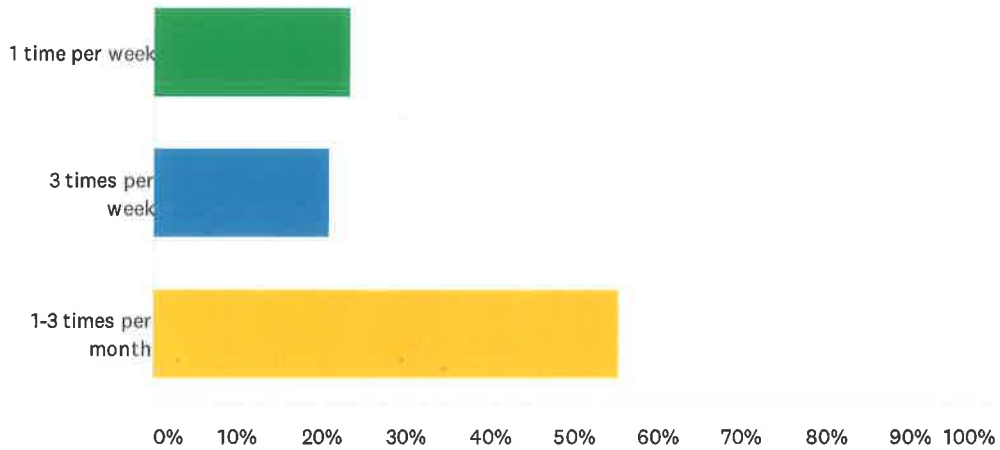

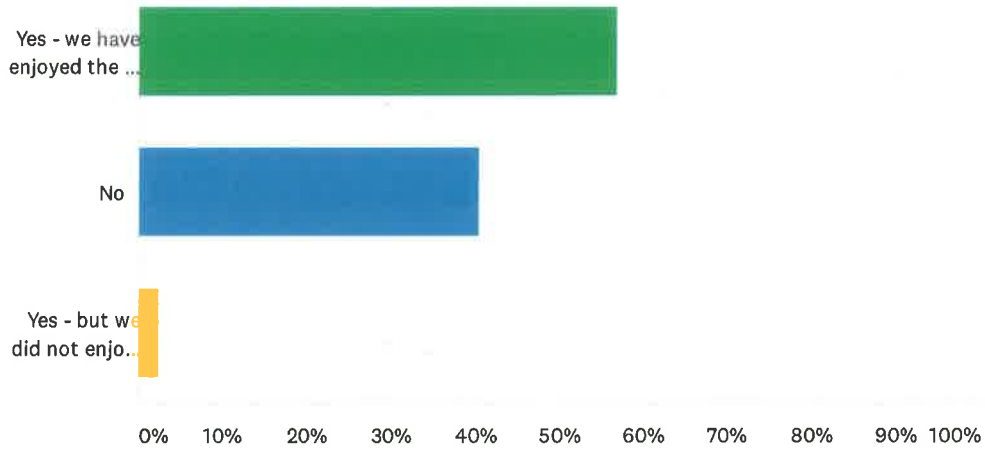

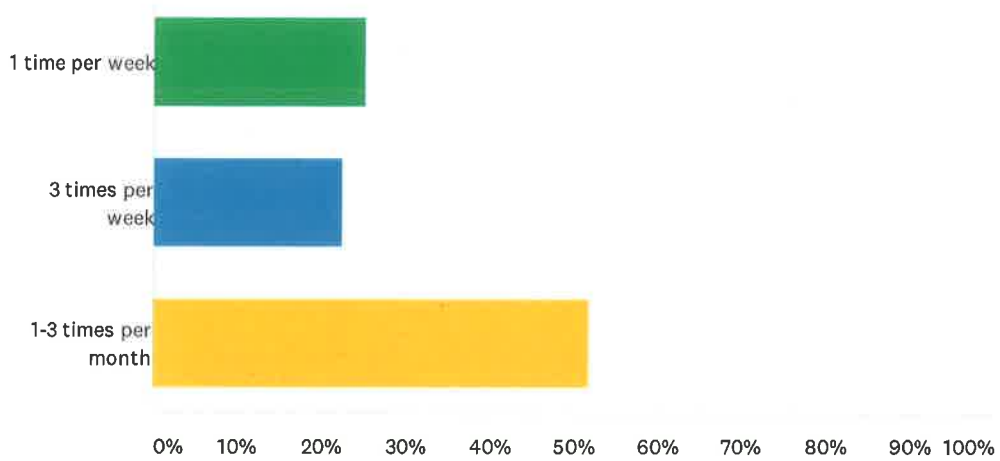

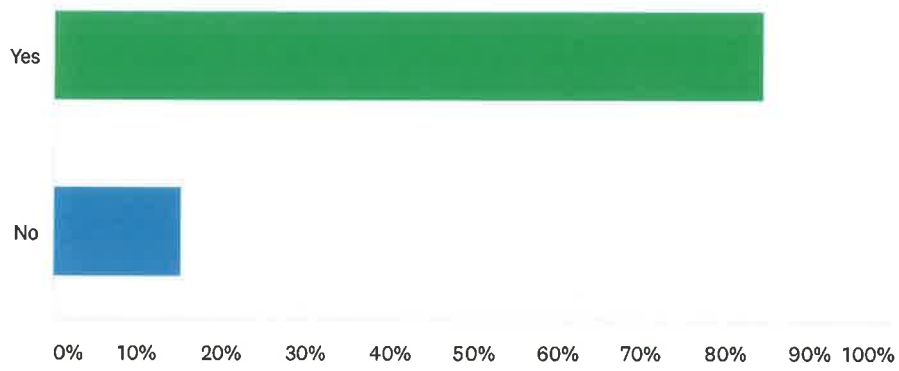

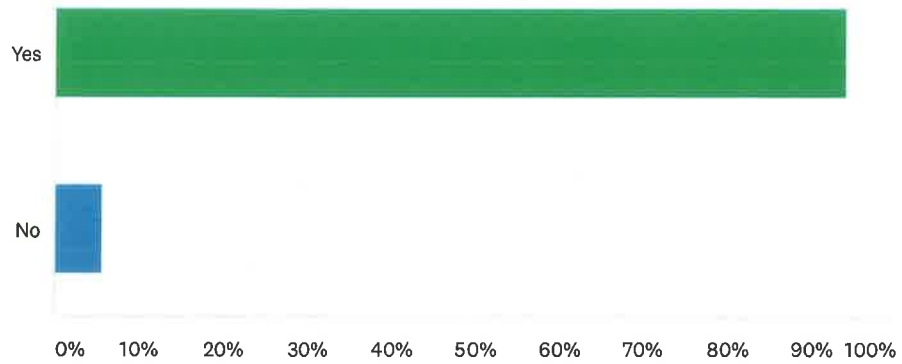

Alternate playground equipment exists, such as the new swings in the North Davis greenbelt, that are at least as appealing and that actually promote exercise (which the ZipTrack does not, as it is a passive "ride"). 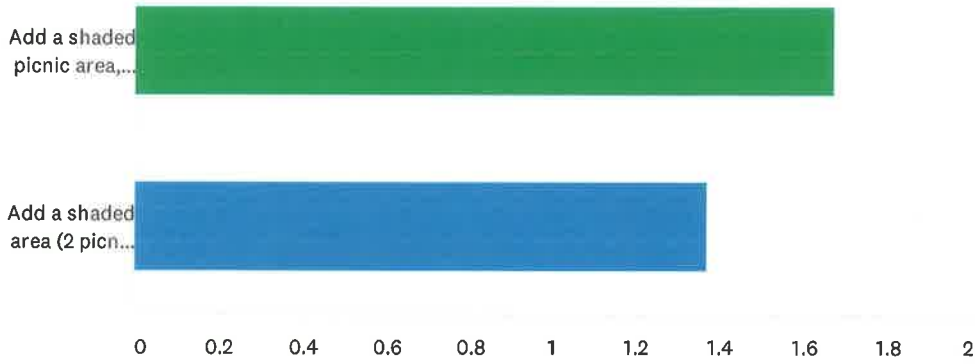

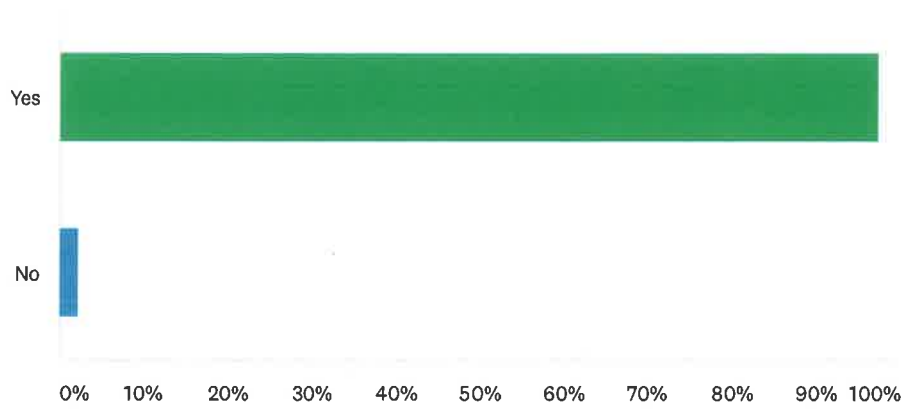

Introduction

Arroyo Park is located at 2000 Shasta Drive in Davis, California. The park includes a zipline near the south-central portion of the park at the approximate location indicated on Figure 1. Photographs of the zipline are included in Appendix B of this report.

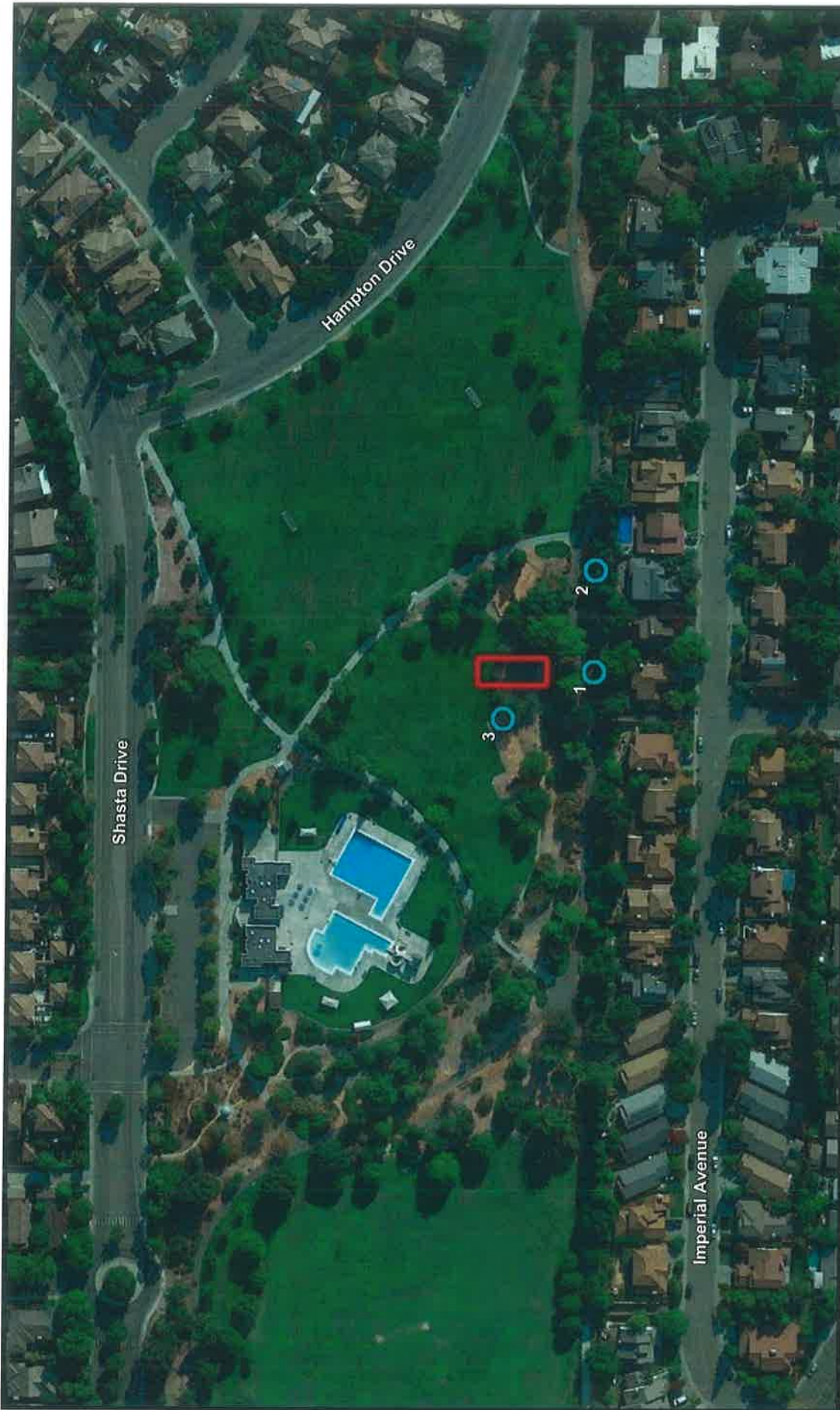
The City of Davis has retained Bollard Acoustical Consultants, Inc. (BAC) to evaluate the noise generated by zipline operations at this park, and to compare those noise levels against applicable City of Davis noise standards at the nearest residences.

Background on Noise and Acoustical Terminology

Noise is often described as unwanted sound. Sound is defined as any pressure variation in air that the human ear can detect. If the pressure variations occur frequently enough (at least 20 times per second), they can be heard and are called sound. The number of pressure variations per second is called the frequency of sound, and is expressed as cycles per second, called Hertz (Hz).

Measuring sound directly in terms of pressure would require a very large and awkward range of numbers. To avoid this, the decibel scale was devised. The decibel scale uses the hearing threshold (20 micropascals of pressure), as a point of reference, defined as 0 dB. Other sound pressures are then compared to the reference pressure, and the logarithm is taken to keep the numbers in a practical range. The decibel scale allows a million-fold increase in pressure to be expressed as 120 dB. Another useful aspect of the decibel scale is that changes in decibel levels correspond closely to human perception of relative loudness.

The perceived loudness of sound is dependent upon many factors, including sound pressure level and frequency content. However, within the usual range of environmental noise levels, perception of loudness is relatively predictable, and can be approximated by weighing the frequency response of a sound level meter by means of the standardized A-weighting network. There is a strong correlation between A-weighted sound levels (expressed as dBA) and community response to noise. For this reason, the A-weighted sound level has become the standard tool of environmental noise assessment. All noise levels reported in this section are in terms of A-weighted levels. Please see Appendix A for definitions of acoustical terminology used in this report. Figure 2 illustrates common noise levels associated with various sources.

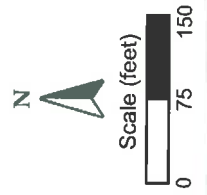
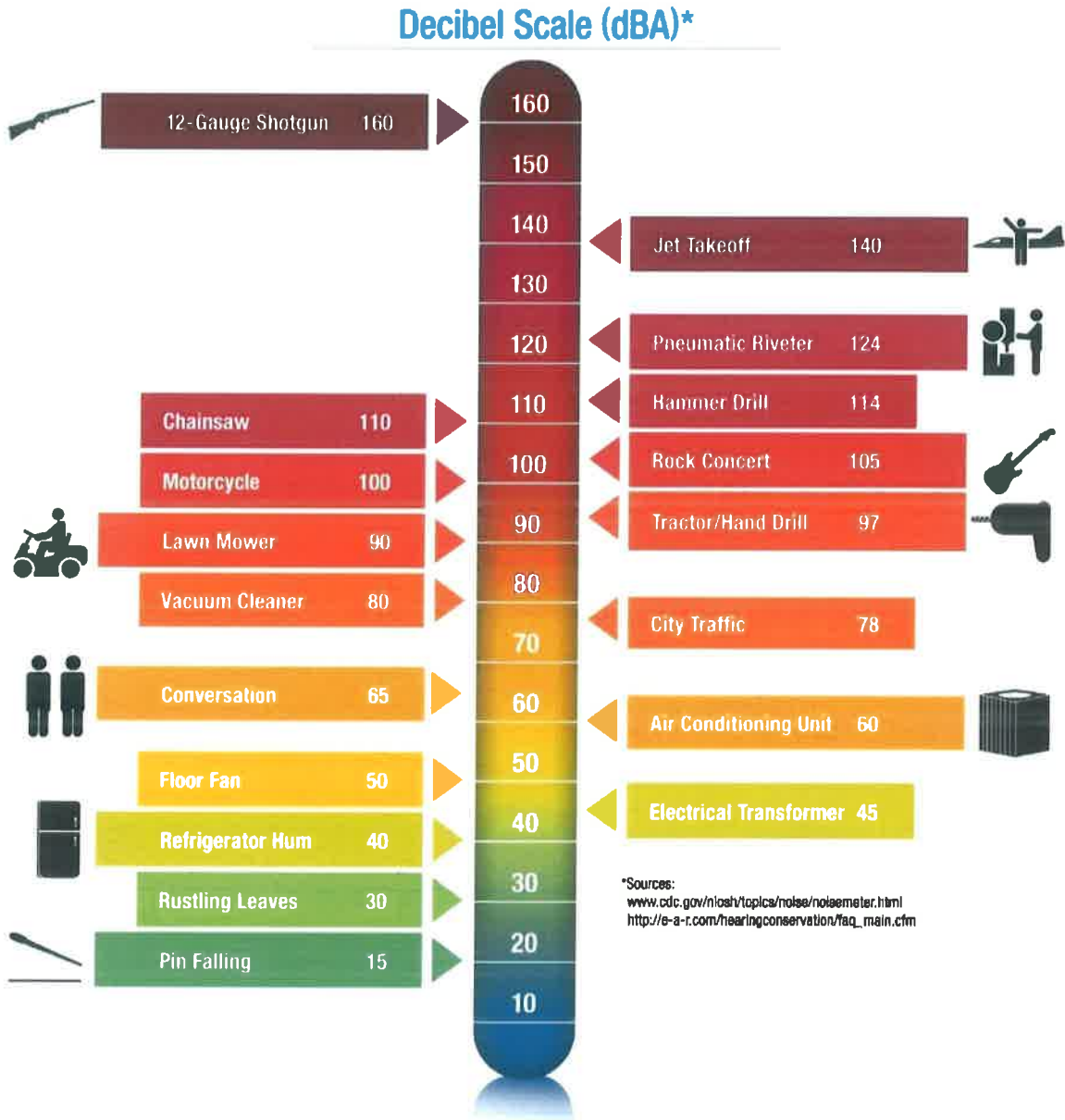

Criteria for Acceptable Noise Exposure

City of Davis Noise Ordinance

The City of Davis Municipal Code Sec. 24.02.020 establishes noise level limits measured at the property boundary at the point closest to the noise source for various land use types for both daytime and nighttime periods. Those noise limits are shown in Table 1 below. The noise level limits shown below are expressed in terms of hourly average noise levels, or L_{eq} .

Because the nearest sensitive uses to the zipline court are residences to the immediate south of the park boundary, and because the zipline activities are limited to daytime hours, the noise standard which would be applicable to this project is a 55 dB hourly average (L_{eq}) at the nearest residential property boundaries.

Zipline Noise Measurement Methodology

To quantify noise generated by zipline activities at Arroyo Park, noise level measurements were conducted on the morning of July 22, 2019. During the measurement period, the two zipline tracks were operated in a near continual fashion by persons of varying weights to simulate worst-case conditions.

Noise level measurements were conducted at the 3 positions in the immediate zipline area indicated on Figure 1. Noise measurement Sites 1 and 2 represent the locations of residences to the immediate south of the zipline. Noise measurement site 3 was located to the east of the zipline area. Appendix B shows representative photographs of the zipline noise measurement program.

Noise level measurement equipment consisted of a Larson Davis Laboratories (LDL) Model 820 and 831 precision integrating sound level meters equipped with LDL Model 2560 microphones. The meters were calibrated before use with an LDL Model CAL200 acoustical calibrator to ensure the accuracy of the measurements. The equipment used meets all pertinent specifications of the American National Standards Institute for Type 1 sound level meters (ANSI S1.4).

Weather conditions during the testing were typical for the period, with warm morning temperatures (80°F), moderate relative humidity (50%), calm winds and clear skies.

Zipline Test Results

The results of the zipline noise measurements are summarized in Table 2 and are presented graphically in Figures 3-6.

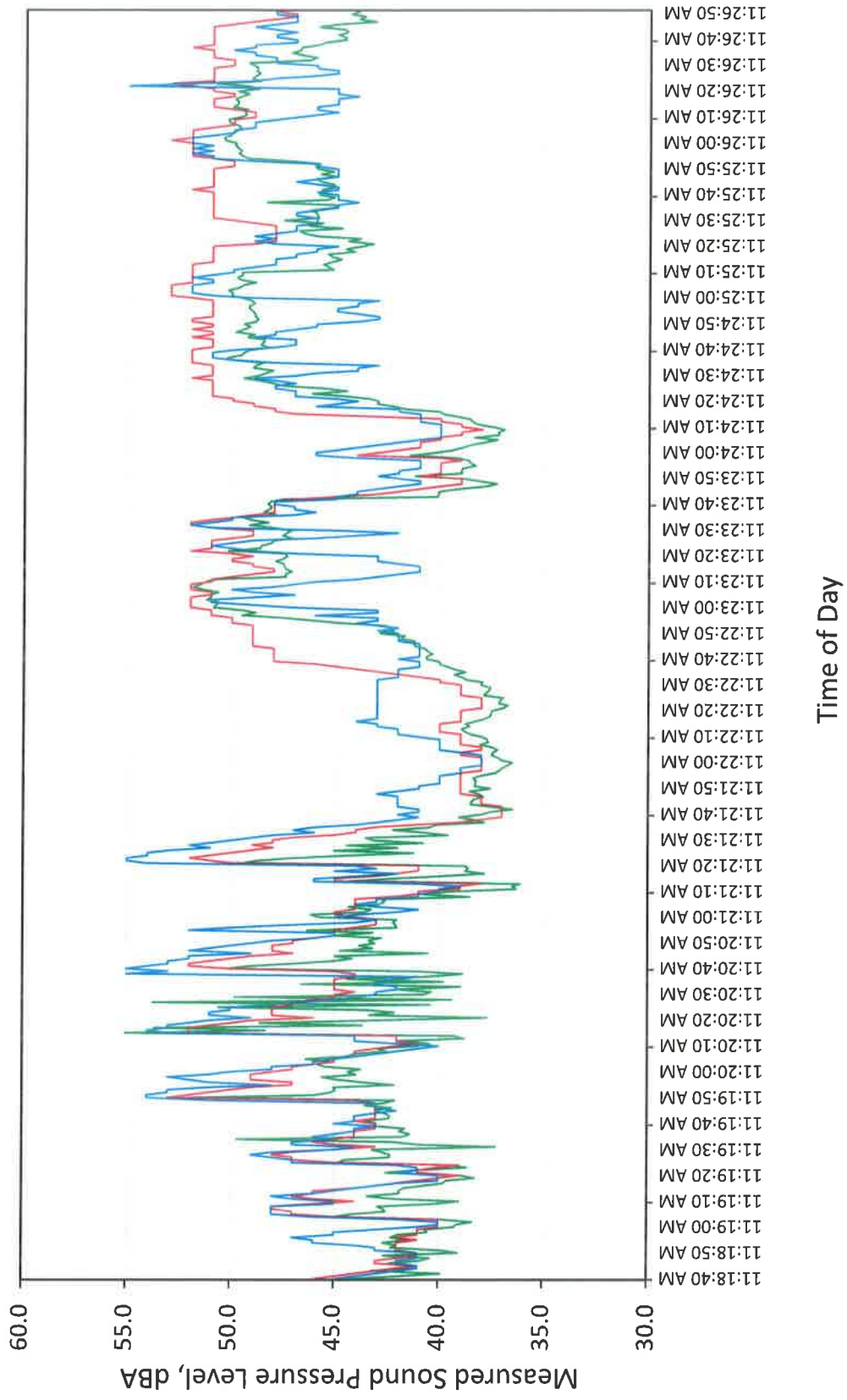

As indicated on Figure 1, Sites 1 and 2 were located along the southern park boundary. As a result, the City's 55 dBA Leq daytime noise level standard would be applicable at those locations. Site 3 was located within the play area to the immediate west of the zipline area. Although the City noise standards would not be applicable at Site 3, this location was used to establish an additional data point location for the survey.

Table 2 indicates that the measured average zipline noise levels were satisfactory relative to the City's 55 dB standard at the nearest residences by a considerable margin (9-11 dB below the standard). The Figure 3 data indicate that the measured maximum noise levels during the zipline usage did not exceed 55 dBA Lmax. Because the instantaneous maximum noise levels did not exceed 55 dBA at any time during the zipline noise test, it would not be possible for average noise levels to exceed the City's 55 dBA daytime level, even with constant usage of both zipline tracks concurrently.

July 22, 2019



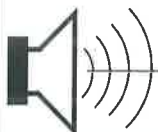
Conclusions

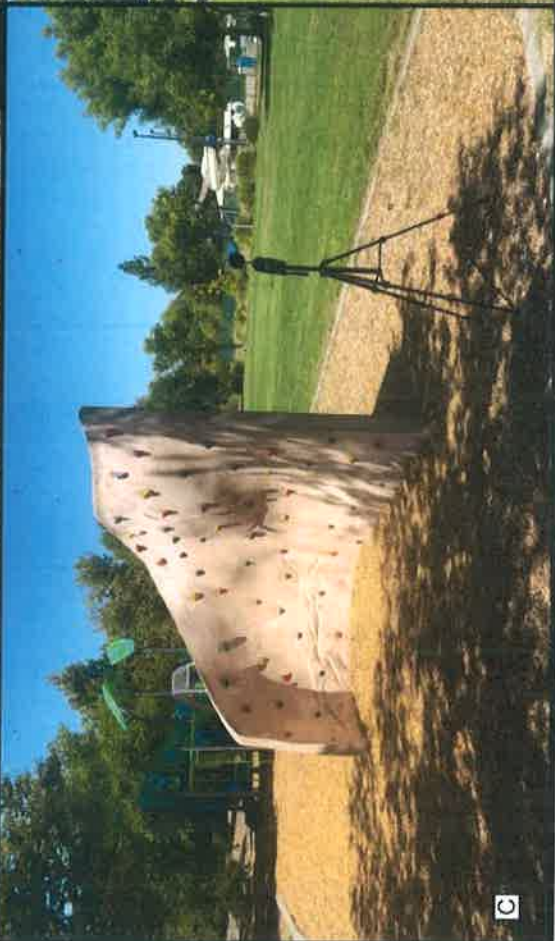
Appendix A Acoustical Terminology

Acoustics	The science of sound.
Ambient Noise	The distinctive acoustical characteristics of a given space consisting of all noise sources audible at that location. In many cases, the term ambient is used to describe an existing or pre-project condition such as the setting in an environmental noise study.
Attenuation	The reduction of an acoustic signal.
A-Weighting	A frequency-response adjustment of a sound level meter that conditions the output signal to approximate human response.
Decibel or dB	Fundamental unit of sound, A Bell is defined as the logarithm of the ratio of the sound pressure squared over the reference pressure squared. A Decibel is one-tenth of a Bell.
CNEL	Community Noise Equivalent Level. Defined as the 24-hour average noise level with noise occurring during evening hours (7 - 10 p.m.) weighted by a factor of three and nighttime hours weighted by a factor of 10 prior to averaging.
Frequency	The measure of the rapidity of alterations of a periodic signal, expressed in cycles per second or hertz.
L_{dn}	Day/Night Average Sound Level. Similar to CNEL but with no evening weighting.
Leq	Equivalent or energy-averaged sound level.
L_{max}	The highest root-mean-square (RMS) sound level measured over a given period of time.
Loudness	A subjective term for the sensation of the magnitude of sound.
Masking	The amount (or the process) by which the threshold of audibility is for one sound is raised by the presence of another (masking) sound.
Noise	Unwanted sound.
Peak Noise	The level corresponding to the highest (not RMS) sound pressure measured over a given period of time. This term is often confused with the Maximum level, which is the highest RMS level.
RT₆₀	The time it takes reverberant sound to decay by 60 dB once the source has been removed.
Sabin	The unit of sound absorption. One square foot of material absorbing 100% of incident sound has an absorption of 1 sabin.
SEL	A rating, in decibels, of a discrete event, such as an aircraft flyover or train passby, that compresses the total sound energy of the event into a 1-s time period.
Threshold of Hearing	The lowest sound that can be perceived by the human auditory system, generally considered to be 0 dB for persons with perfect hearing.
Threshold of Pain	Approximately 120 dB above the threshold of hearing.
