Commissioner Furillo: YCTD update on Yolo Active Transportation Corridor Plan and shared two prioritized segments. Shared that this is his last meeting and moving out of Davis.

City Traffic Engineer and Assistant Director, PWET Ryan Chapman: Working on 3rd and B Street bike and pedestrian sensor project. Collecting data on 5th Street for baseline data for I Street, J Street, and K Street project.

C. Safe Routes to School Program Update.

B. Ostrom requested change to meeting minutes change Nicky to Vicky in the April minutes.

6. Regular Items

A. Davis Senior High students in the Race and Social Justice class presentation on transportation issues.

Students presented on their challenges to get to school on time and survey results. Presentation focused on those who drive, as drivers were more likely to be late to school.

Public comment:

Trish Price: Shared that driving is not the only way to get to school.

Commission discussion included asking students about data and highlighting those students who bike and walk to school are more likely to arrive on time.

B. Traffic safety near schools with DJUSD and Davis Police

City Traffic Engineer and Assistant Director, PWET Ryan Chapman: Provided a brief intro about evaluating school sites and making recommendations. He introduced Police Sargent John Renger and DJUSD Director of Student Support Cara Messmore.

Public Comment:

Trish Price: Need to better control speeds around schools and reduce speeds to 20 miles per hour. Separate cars from bikes and pedestrians. She recommended new paths to connect to school sites.

Stacey Clark: Shared an experience as a former crossing guard at Birch and Covell Boulevard about an incident on March 19, 2025.

Commissioner discussion included how Davis Police are posted at school sites, a desire to learn from the Netherlands about best practices, they wanted to know if schools are sharing crash data with parents. They asked for a future presentation about innovative ideas and a quick-build toolbox to address these issues.

C. Moving Transportation Forward Plan.

City Traffic Engineer and Assistant Director, PWET Ryan Chapman and Senior Transportation Planner, Jennifer Donofrio: Shared the Plan overview and introduced the elements of the Plan.

Public Comment:

Trish Price: Lighting around pathways and streets maintenance needs to be prioritized.

Commissioner discussion included how projects are prioritized, using data, and improving traffic signals for people on bikes.

Lee moved, seconded by S. Campbell, recommend City Council approve the Moving Transportation Forward Plan. Motion passed by the following vote:
